VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Beautification -- This committee helps to keep the school grounds free of weeds and full of new flowers, etc., usually in front of the auditorium and front entrance.

Chaperones -- This committee chaperones dances, Renaissance activities, Junior Initiative lunch, etc. You will be contacted during the year as needed.

Class Liaisons -- These are volunteers who help with each class's fundraising efforts, dances and events.

Contacting Volunteers -- This committee calls/emails other members when help is needed with fund raising, day or night school events, etc. This can be done day or evening.

Fundraising -- These volunteers will help increase PTO's ability to support the school by raising money through programs such as eScrip, ACME scrip and Target Take Charge of Education, etc.

Hospitality -- This is one committee that even the working parents can join. You don't have to attend any of the functions, just bring food or supplies. By doing this, we can keep down the expenses incurred by PTO for functions such as Back to School Night, Teacher Appreciation Week, etc. **Chairperson(s) needed for Teacher Appreciation Luncheon in November.**

Publicity -- Every parent can participate... If your child is involved in sports, band, orchestra, choir, plays, etc. and you have taken pictures you would like to have published, just bring them into the office and the secretaries will forward them to the right people for submission to the local papers. This is one way to show that our kids have *school spirit*.

Senior Project Interviewer -- This position entails your helping to grade senior projects by listening to oral presentations made by the students about their experience before they graduate. The teacher contact is Mr. Robert McCormick who can be reached at the school by phone or email.

Special Skills/Talent -- Anyone interested in donating a special skill/talent/area of expertise to improve the school/grounds. Examples are landscaping, painting, carpentry, etc.

Volleyball Games -- **Chairperson(s)** is needed. This evening event is held twice a year as a fund raiser for Breakfast. Help will also be needed for referees, admissions or snack bar.

Breakfast '09 -- **Co-Chairperson** is needed. Parents of all grades are needed to help with various functions of the after the senior prom party and activities.
