

Right to Know Law, Act 159 Compliance

The Hazardous Substance Survey Form (HSSF) is a document that has been developed to collect information about hazardous substances, special hazardous substances and environmental hazards that may be present at a work site.

The purposes of the HSSF are to:

- provide local emergency response organizations with an inventory of hazardous substances at a facility to assist with planning for and responding to emergencies; and
- provide the public with information about hazardous substances at facilities in their communities.

The completed HSSF provides an inventory of the hazardous substances that were present at a work site during the prior calendar year ***shall be completed no later than April 1 of each year.***

Per Act 159, the Marple Newtown School District's Right to Know program has been updated for calander year 2008.
