

# Important SAT Test Day Information

## Marple Newtown High School

**November 7, 2020 and December 5, 2020**

The following protocols have been put into place to ensure the health and safety of students on test day as well as testing security as outlined by College Board. Students who do not meet the requirements listed below will not be permitted to test.

### **You will not be admitted to the test center without:**

- SAT Admission Ticket
- Photo ID (School ID, Driver's License, or Passport)- If you do not have a photo ID, you must get this form completed by your high school prior to test day: [get the form here.](#)
- Face Mask

### **You should also bring:**

- #2 Pencil (not mechanical)
- Approved Calculator: [see list here](#)
- Water and Snack

### **Test Day Procedures:**

- There will be 4 separate testing entrances based on the first letter of the student's last name. Please use this map to find your check-in location: [see map.](#)
  - A-F: Door 17
  - G-L: Door 14
  - M-R: Door 11
  - S-Z: Door 1
- Doors will open promptly at 7:45am and registration/check-in will end at 8:15am.
- Students and parents are expected to self-monitor prior to reporting for testing and stay home should any signs of illness be present. Students are also asked to stay home on test day if they are returning from any "hot spot" within 14 days. Students are expected to take their temperature 30 minutes before arriving at the building. Students who are exhibiting signs

of illness and/or are returning from any hot spot states should contact College Board to reschedule their exam.

- Students will be asked to sign the COVID-19 Safety Screening Form upon arrival: [see Safety Screening Form here](#). Students can print and complete this form prior to arriving on test day. Students who do not sign the form will not be admitted to the testing center. These students will need to contact College Board to reschedule their exam.
- Face Masks must be worn at all times while in the building.
- Cell phones will be collected before testing starts and will only be returned to students after testing concludes.
